Oregon Congressional Delegation

The Oregon Water Resources Congress provided your office with prepared a packet of materials in late December 2008 and early January 2009 of “shovel ready” projects eligible for anticipated federal funding through the economic stimulus package.

We prepared the attached table, Summary of District Projects, in response to requests from the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and from several State Legislative offices for additional information. It also reflects changes as districts have refined their projects and conditions have changed. We are providing this as supplemental information to the packet of information that we previously submitted to your office.

The projects proposed by our members are

- Water conservation projects (canal piping),
- Renewable energy (small hydropower plants that are installed in the canals and use existing water rights), and
- Fish protection (fish screens at diversion points).

This list may include some projects for which NEPA compliance has not been completed. Those projects are not being submitted for federal funding but are included on this list because we are using the list for both federal and state funding opportunities.
